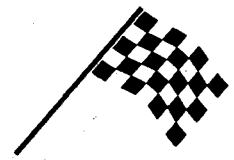

We thought you'd like to know.....

- Each driver gets one practice run that does not count in competition.
- Class S racing is on a double-elimination basis. I.E., a driver is not eliminated until having two losses. Classes A, B and C race on a triple-elimination basis.
- The six fastest cars in class A, B and C become "finalists" and compete in the Finals racing for 1st, 2nd and 3rd within their class. The 1st place cars in each class go on to compete for the title of "Champion of Champions."
- All decisions made by the Technical Committee are final.

-When a car is eliminated from competition and the car number is announced, the DRIVERS / PIT CREWS ARE TO REMOVE THEIR OWN WHEELS AND BRACKETS.
These items should be turned in at the building, west side of the pit area.
Loaner tools will be available.

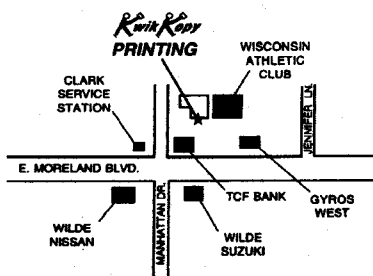

- The New Berlin Police Department was the driving force in starting the Derby in 1965.
- The New Berlin Soap Box Derby has been postponed due to weather only twice in 38 years!!!
