MORE INFORMATION ABOUT THE NEW BERLIN SOAP BOX DERBY

- >Drivers have the option to carry-over their car numbers from the previous year, or they may choose new car numbers on a first-come basis.
- >Car number 1 is reserved for the defending "Champion of Champions."
- >Drivers randomly draw for their sponsors each year on a first-come basis. Sponsors are not carried over year-to-year.
- >Drivers and crews select their own wheels and axle brackets from Commission-supplied stock. At the end of the event, the Champion's wheels and axle brackets are locked-up and are taken out of circulation for one year.
- >The New Berlin Police Department was the driving force for starting the Derby in 1965.
- >The Derby has been postponed due to weather only twice in 41 years!
- >The Derby Commission is a non-profit corporation consisting of volunteers interested in kids and racing. The Commission operates independently of, but in cooperation with, the City of New Berlin and the

New Berlin Parks, Recreation & Forestry Department.

>Our track facilities were built, and are maintained, with private funds, and are donated to the City of New Berlin.
